## **Dog Policy**

*We love dogs and are very happy to welcome them into our home and holiday cottage and hope they have a lovely holiday – a maximum of two is permitted*

*Your dog(s) must be up to date on it's annual 'jabs', deflead and wormed prior to arrival. It should have not been resident in a kennels or other similar location within the last 8 weeks or have suffered from kennel cough in the last 6 months*

*We expect your dog(s) to be well socialised as they may meet another dog staying with us or our own dog. If you dog(s) is(are) aggressive in any way we reserve the right to ask you to remove the animal(s) from our premises. Please ensure your dog(s) do/does not yap or bark as this can disturb other guests and our neighbours*

*We can provide doggy towels for your use – please ensure your dog is dry and clean before taking them to your room / into the holiday cottage*

*B&B: Please do not leave your dog in your room alone or unattended in the garden*

*Ysgubor Cottage: If you bring a pet with you, it is not allowed upstairs, in the bedrooms or on beds or furniture. You must never leave any pets unattended in the property, including the garden, and you must keep dog(s) on a lead within the garden. Please note - our fencing is 'stock-proof' and not 'dog-proof' fencing - dogs are able to squeeze under or through the fencing/gates or may jump over it. Please ensure dogs are cleaned/dried thoroughly when they come in from outside. If you or any member of the party has a pet allergy, we cannot accept any responsibility for any subsequent health reaction*

*Please always clean up after you dog, including on the lanes and in our fields when they are available. A dedicated bin is provided by the garage for disposal. If you dog causes any damage we would expect you to pay for replacement / repair and potential loss of revenue if the room/cottage needs to be decommissioned*

*We have spare leads, poop bags, bowls and food if you forget anything*
